The children were so interested in the gingerbread house from


Hansel and Gretel so we decided to make our own. They rolled and cut the dough, which helps to

Shapes! We've been revising our shapes this week. We made tangram pictures using shapes and practised our cutting and sticking skills.






Last Friday we made gingerbread, inspired by Hansel and Gretel. The children had turns measuring and pouring ingredients. We practised using language such as more, less, etc.

- Can we kindly ask for you to refrain from bringing toys into Nursery. We are finding it tricky to keep track of them and cannot be responsible if they go missing or break.
- We go to the Library every Thursday, so please send your library books back on a Wednesday or a Thursday so that the children can choose a new book.
