- Assembly at the main school building continues on Thursdays and Fridays. Please drop your child off at the main school building between 8 and 8:20 on these mornings.
- Can we kindly ask for you to refrain from bringing toys into Nursery. We are finding it tricky to keep track of them and cannot be responsible if they go missing or break.
- We go to the Library every Thursday, so please send your library books back on a Wednesday or a Thursday so that the children can choose a new book.
- Thank you so much for sending in the pictures of your child for their timeline poster! We would like to invite the parents to come and have a look at our projects on **Monday 25th March** at drop off time in the morning.
- Grandparents Morning is on **Wednesday 27th March** from 10:45 to 11:30, finishing at pick-up time. Join us in making some Easter baskets and an Easter egg hunt! If a grandparent is not able to make the event, another relative or friend is welcome. If this is not possible, please do not worry as all children will still have lots of fun with the teachers!
