In English, the class have been internalising part of our model text: a portal story about a girl who briefly enters a magical world at the end of her garden.

After spending more time on History last term, our new topic, *Investigating India*, focuses on Geography, both human and physical. The children had a great time researching in our first lesson by finding facts which were scattered around the room.
