What have we explored this week?

This week, we began our next English topic: how to write a 'meeting tale'. This is based on Michael Morpurgo's novel 'This Morning I Met a Whale', which we read together as a class and will be exploring in more detail over the coming weeks.

In Maths, the children learned how to measure and draw angles accurately using a protractor, as well as calculate angles around a point and on a straight line.

Our current Geography topic is the United Kingdom. The class spent Tuesday afternoon investigating the names of the counties of the UK; next week, we will be zooming in on particular towns and cities.
