This week in English, the children continued learning about the different features of a persuasive letter. As a class, they then created a toolkit to use in persuasive writing tasks. In Maths, the children focused on comparing decimal numbers, using the greater than and less than symbols and practised rounding decimal numbers to the nearest whole number. The children also learned the relationships between halves, quarters and decimals.

They also learned about the positive impact the Windrush Generation had on Britain and the success stories of famous individuals, including Linford Christie, Baroness Floella Benjamin and
