Year 2 Newsletter: Autumn Term 1, Week 4

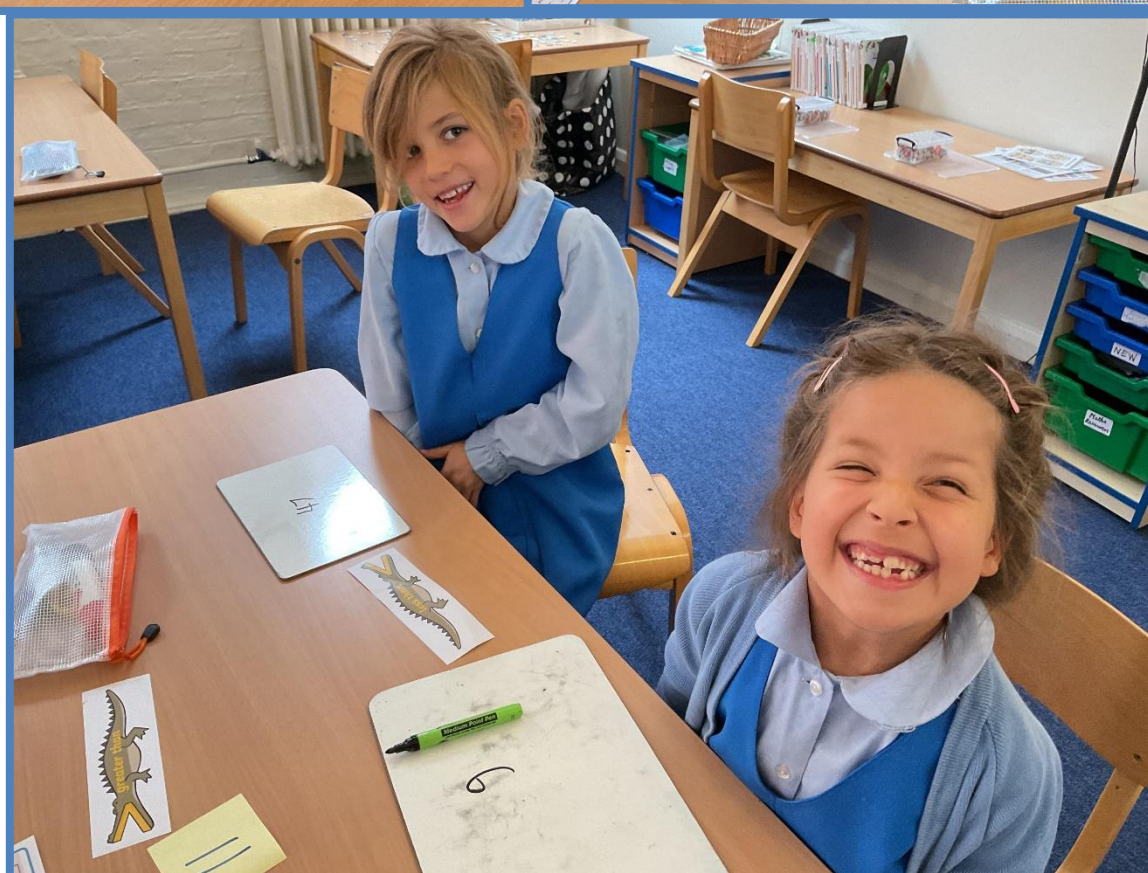
What have we explored this week?
