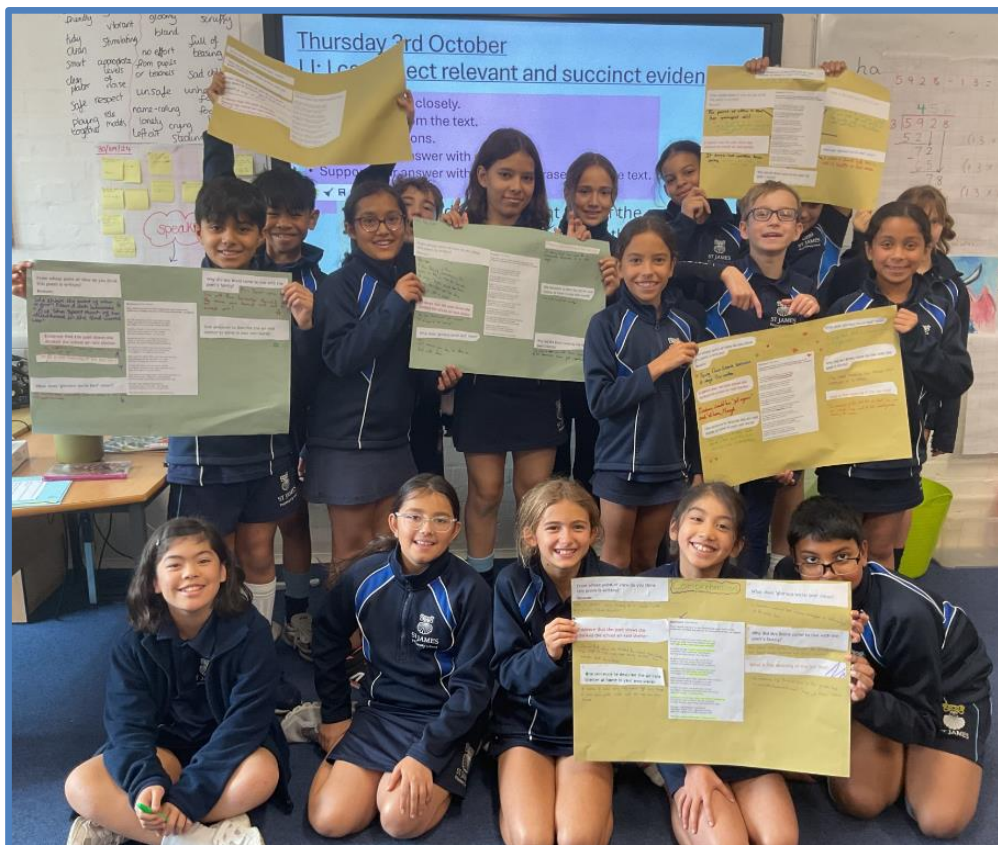
Year 6 Newsletter: Autumn, Week 5
