

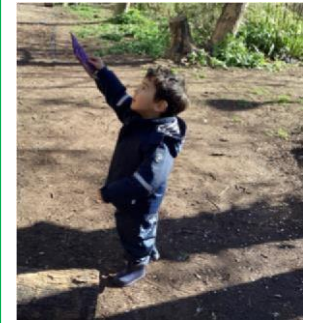


Nursery Newsletter: Spring Term, Week 11

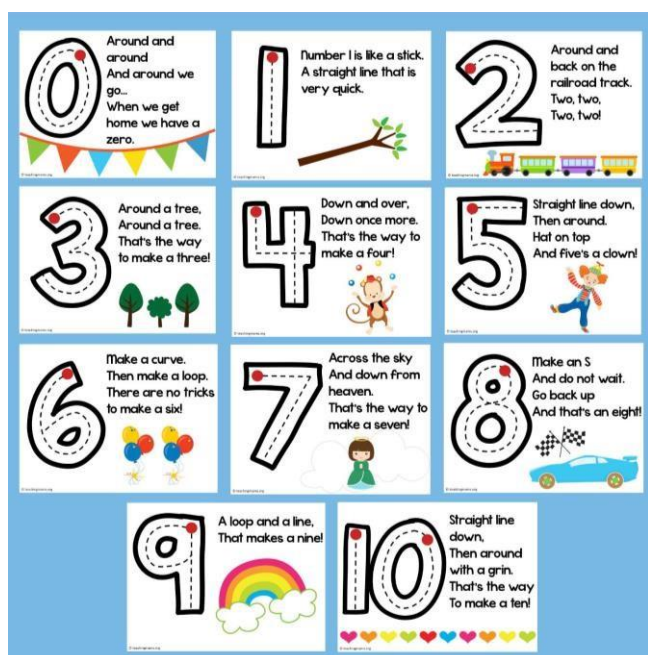
What are the teachers doing during the Easter break?

Lots of parents asked about number formation in the Parent Teacher Interviews this week. Here are the rhymes we use at Nursery:

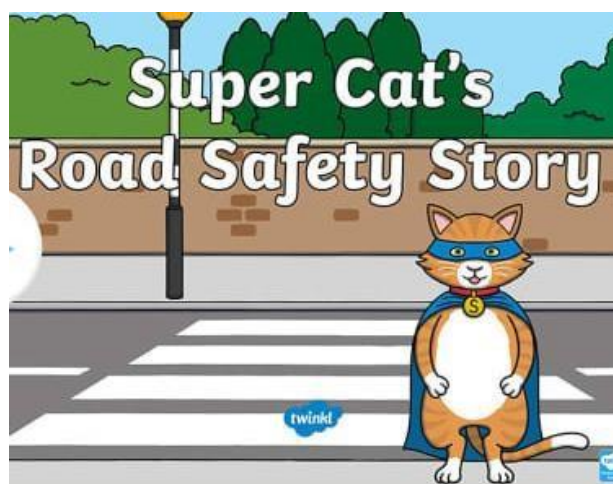
