



### Packed Lunch Option

St James considers good nutrition to be essential. Our school lunches are vegetarian and prepared on the premises using wholesome fresh produce. We do not use any pre-produced sauces which may contain GM foods. We do not permit nuts in the school. We request that all cakes and food items brought into school by pupils must be nut free and do not contain alcohol. We must insist that packed lunches reflect this policy. In addition we ask that packed lunches do not include chocolate, crisps, fizzy drinks, sweets, meat or fish products.
